

Your Online Marriage Information Guide

What we provide, what Utah County requires, and how to prepare.

Simply Married Online provides an authorized officiant who is physically present in Utah, conducts your ceremony by live video, and submits the completed marriage information electronically to Utah County. We are an independent service and are not affiliated with or endorsed by Utah County.

THE PROCESS

Four straightforward steps

1. Apply Apply directly through Utah County. Each applicant completes, signs, and completes the county identity-verification process.	2. Send the license After approval, use the county's instructions to send the private digital license to your officiant.	3. Join live video Both partners, the officiant, and two witnesses age 18 or older must see and hear one another live.	4. Receive the record After the ceremony, the officiant submits electronically and Utah County processes the certificate.
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Utah County says the license has no waiting period and must be used within 32 days after issuance.

What to expect

Depending on the booking option selected, the couple provides both witnesses or Simply Married Online provides both witnesses. Guests are still welcome.

Before the ceremony

Have a valid, unexpired Utah County license and send it through the county's approved process. Confirm both partners and both adult witnesses can attend. Use a working camera, microphone, speakers, and reliable internet. Join from a quiet, well-lit place and have identification available if requested.

What is not included

Utah County license charges, payment-processing fees, certified copies, shipping, apostilles, authentications, translations, and other third-party services are separate and controlled by their providers.

A Utah marriage performed by online remote appearance may not be accepted in every country or for every immigration, visa, religious, benefits, or administrative purpose. Before paying, confirm the requirements wherever you plan to use the record. We do not provide legal or immigration advice or guarantee recognition outside Utah.
